Chevening partners with a range of organisations, including private corporations, UK universities, charities, trusts and foundations.

Partnerships are agreed through a memorandum of understanding signed with the FCDO. Chevening looks after all aspects of partnership administration, from managing the application process to making payments to universities and scholars.

Scholars know that their award has been made possible by their partner, and their scholarship bears the partner's name. Partners can be involved in the scholar selection process. They can engage with scholars while they are in the UK and after they return home.
